

The Five Mobilization Dental Processing Requirements

1. Complete military dental record.
2. Annual periodic dental examination.
3. Panoraphic and supporting radiographs.
4. Current dental readiness data entry into MEDPROS.
5. Class 3 dental treatment completed prior to SRP mobilization date.

Military Dental Record Requirements

Military Dental Record Content Requirements- All forms are to be completed and signed prior to the SRP.

- a. Military dental record jacket
- b. DA Form 5570, Health Questionnaire envelope
- c. DD Form 2005, Privacy Act Statement
- d. SF 603/603A and/or DD Form 2813
- e. Panoraphic and supporting radiographs
- f. HIPAA NOPP (Notice of Privacy Practices) Acknowledgement label

Annual Periodic Dental Examination

Documentation of a current periodic dental examination (not screening), which is performed according to DoD Guidelines for a Periodic Oral Evaluation, procedure code D0120. This type of exam requires the use of a mirror, probe, periodontal screening and supporting radiographs.

An annual periodic dental examination by a non-government contracted civilian dentist (e.g. private dentist) will be documented on DD Form 2813 (Active Duty/Reserve Forces Dental Examination). An annual periodic dental examination by a military or government-contracted dentist will be documented on SF 603/603A (Dental Health Record).

Panoraphic and Supporting Radiograph Requirements

The frequency of prescribing radiographs is based upon the clinical judgment of the soldier's dentist and existing practice guidelines, including HHS Publication No. FDA 88-8273.

Radiographs should be of diagnostic quality, properly identified and dated and should be placed in the military dental record. A panoraphic radiograph of adequate quality for diagnostic and identification purposes is required in the dental record. There is no time requirement on updating panoraphic radiographs. However, the panoraphic radiograph will adequately represent the current oral condition of the Soldier.

Dental Readiness MEDPROS Data

Dental readiness classification results of the annual periodic dental examination and any subsequent treatment that changes the readiness classification are required to be entered into the MEDPROS data system before the mob station SRP date.

Class 3 Treatment

Class 3 Treatment is required to be completed before dental mobilization processing. Class 3 treatment needs that are not completed before the SRP must be clearly documented on a SF603/603A and placed into the military dental record. If a soldier received a dental classification through his private dentist using a DD2813 that indicates Class 3 treatment needs, a new DD2813 is required prior to the SRP indicating a new classification if all Class 3 treatment needs were completed. Class 3 treatment that changes the adequacy of the existing panoraphic radiograph to reflect current oral conditions requires a new panoraphic radiograph before the SRP.
