

U.S. v. SFC R. Torres

April 16, according to pleas of guilty, a general court-martial convicted Sgt. 1st Class Gerardo Rosario-Torres, HHB, USAADA Center & Fort Bliss, Garrison Command, of the larceny of \$5,000 of military property through the improper use of his government IMPAC card, wire fraud, and making false official statements to CID agents investigating his criminal misconduct. Rosario-Torres was sentenced to reduction to the grade of E1, total forfeiture of all pay and allowances, a \$5,000 fine, 18 months confinement, and a bad conduct discharge. Rosario-Torres, who had more than 18 years of service, lost all benefits, including his retirement, as a result of his conviction.
