SUBJECT: Open Door Policy (Policy Letter 1-2)

2. Should a time arise when an individual desires to see me, I will, to the maximum extent possible, assist any member of the 32d AAMDC, including Soldiers, Family members and civilians. My intent is to listen and assist with a solution that is in the best interest of the individual, the unit and this command. Although you are not required to obtain chain of command approval before speaking to me, you are encouraged to use your chain of command and attempt to resolve issues at the lowest possible level.
3. The 32d AAMDC's worldwide mission requires frequent absences from my office and Fort Bliss. Therefore, individuals desiring to see me can schedule an appointment by contacting the 32d AAMDC SGS at (915) 568-2043/1673. Enlisted Soldiers should meet with the CSM prior to seeing me. Although Soldiers do not have to discuss their situation/issues with the CSM, I do ask that, as a courtesy, Soldiers need to inform him of their desire to see me.
