


# Arrange TA-50 according to the example below



# FAQ Regarding Equipment Turn-In

## 1. Can I ship or mail my equipment prior to my arrival at CRC?

No. If your gear/RFI is not turned in at Fort. Bliss, or is at another location, you will be responsible for any gear to be turned in, so please make arrangements to get all items you were issued for deployment. If you are missing any gear/RFI, you may receive a statement of charges.

## 2. What equipment do I turn in at CIF?

OCIE required for turn-in will depend upon your deployment location. For specific guidance on your personal turn-in, you will need to contact our Supply NCOIC.

\*FOR NATIONAL GUARDSMEN AND RESERVIST – Plan on turning in everything issued for deployment ONLY (not unit issued items).

\*FOR ACTIVE DUTY SOLDIERS – RFI and current deployment issue ONLY (not items issued at your duty station).

## 3. Do I need to bring a copy of my clothing record with me to CIF?

No. A FLIPL may be initiated for stolen or misplaced gear and RFI, if a statement of charges will not reconcile shortages.

**Please note:** Upon arrival at CRC billeting, all OCIE (*for turn-in*) will be separated and loaded onto a supplied box truck the morning of the next working day. Please pack and store these items separately for easier access and convenience. See attachment for layout.
