SUBJECT: Fort Bliss Deployment Containers Return Policy


1. References:

2. This policy applies to all Active, Reserve, and National Guard units assigned to or mobilized at Fort Bliss, Texas. Department of The Army and HQ, FORSCOM have issued guidance in the accountability, storage, repairs, issue and recovery of all government owned ISO deployable containers.

3. Effective immediately, all units returning to Fort Bliss after a deployment, with ISO 20 foot containers which were issued at Fort Bliss or at any other military installation prior to their departure, will return the ISO containers to the Unit Movement Branch NLT 15 days after the containers return to Fort Bliss.

4. The Installation Container Control Officer, Unit Movement Branch, is responsible for the accountability, repair and issue/reissue of ISO containers to all deploying units. The availability of certified deployable containers is limited and the prompt return of these containers will ensure that enough containers are available to issue to future deploying units.
