What is ASAP and what is it responsible for?

The ASAP program is a well rounded program, providing services in substance abuse prevention and data collection, early substance abuse identification through testing and if necessary treatment/counseling services.

What can ASAP do at Unit level?

ASAP provides resources for awareness training and education, marketing the deterrent effect of drug testing and secondary early identification of possible substance abusers. Once Identified as possible abusers, those Soldiers are screened to determine the need for clinical counseling services and provide recommendations to the Chain of Command.

What is the ultimate goal of ASAP?

The ultimate goal of counseling services is to restore to duty those Soldiers that have the potential for continued military service.

*ASAP provides Prevention Education Services Drug and Alcohol Testing and early identification and Treatment/Counseling Services.
