ARMY VALUES

Discuss the Army Values. “LDRSHIP”

(DISCUSSION) Ask the Soldiers what the seven (7) core Army Values are and what they mean to them.

- Loyalty:

- Bear true faith and allegiance to the US Constitution, the Army, your unit, and other Soldiers.
- Believing in & devoting yourself to someone or something.

- Duty:

- Fulfill your obligations.
- Accomplishing missions as part of a team; avoiding “shortcuts”.



ARMY VALUES

Discuss the Army Values.

(DISCUSSION) Ask the Soldiers what the seven (7) core Army Values are and what they mean to them.

- Respect:

- Treat people as they should be treated.
- Respect: Trusting that all people have done their jobs and fulfilled their duty.
- Self-respect: Results from knowing you have put forth your best effort.

-Selfless Service:

- Put the welfare of the Nation, the Army and your subordinates before your own.
- Basic building block: Commitment of each member to go a little farther, endure a little longer, and look closer on how they can add to the effort.



ARMY VALUES

Discuss the Army Values.

(DISCUSSION) Ask the Soldiers what the seven (7) core Army Values are and what they mean to them.

- Honor

- Live up the Army values.
- Solidified with every value choice you make.

- Integrity

- Do what's right, legally and morally.
- Do and say nothing that deceives others.

- Personal Courage

- Face fear, danger or adversity (physical or moral).
- Build your personal courage by standing up for and acting upon things you know are honorable.
