CONSIDERATION OF OTHERS (CO2)

1. What is consideration of others (CO2)?

"Those actions that indicate a sensitivity to and regard for the feelings and needs of others and an awareness of the impact of one's own behavior on them; being supportive of and fair with others."

2. Typical Interpretations of CO2

- b) Be civil to each other
- c) Treat everyone with respect and dignity
- d) Be professional
- e) Use the "Golden Rule" – treat everyone how you would like to be treated yourself

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3. What are Non-CO2 behaviors?
