EO vs. IG

1. What is Equal Opportunity (EO)?
 - a) The right of all persons to participate in and benefit from programs and activities for which they are qualified.
 - b) Programs and activities will be free from social, personal, or institutional barriers that prevent people from rising to the highest level of accountability possible.
 - c) Persons will be evaluated **ONLY** on individual merit, fitness, capability, and potential, regardless of **race, color, sex, national origin, or religion**, except as prescribed by statute, or other Service policy.

EO vs. IG

2. What is the Inspector General's Office (IG)?

They enhance mission accomplishment by identifying and recommending solutions to performance inhibitors and resolving requests for assistance from Soldiers, Family members and civilians throughout the installation. This is done through four functions:

 - a) Assistance
 - b) Inspection
 - c) Investigation
 - d) Teaching and Training
