



# SEXUAL ASSAULT AWARENESS

(This card is used to facilitate instruction, questions to ask – answers ETC... If the back is required – that’s OK – but try to limit to one card for reference)

- **Fact:** There is no “typical” sexual offender.
- **Fact:** 43% of all rapes/sexual assaults occur between 6 p.m. and midnight.
- **Fact:** Six out of every 10 rapes/sexual assaults occur in the homes of victims, family members, or friends.
- **Fact:** According to the National Violence Against Women Survey, approximately 302,100 women and 92,700 men are forcibly raped in the United States each year.
- Sexual assault is rarely an impulsive act although sometimes sex offenders take advantage of opportunity to offend.
- Offenders most often know their victims and use these relationships to set up situations in which a chosen victim can be sexually assaulted.

- The offender is counting on society to perpetuate the belief that “niceness” cannot co-exist with violence, evil, or deviance
- Over the limit – sexually explicit jokes; hugging, touching or kissing; Links sexuality and aggression in language or behavior (e.g. sexualized threats or insults, like “whore” or “slut”); sexual harassment.
