SUBJECT: Command Religious Program

1. The spiritual development of Soldiers is a joint opportunity and challenge for the Garrison Commander and the Garrison Chaplain. The GC is responsible for promoting the program, which provides for the religious needs and moral guidance of Soldiers assigned to the unit.
2. Programs that can help include Worship Opportunities, Pastoral Care, Family Enrichment Programs, Religious Education and Ministry of Presence.
3. Commanders and Directors will offer Soldiers and civilians the opportunity to attend events which appeal to their religious needs. Attempt to accommodate religious worship, dietary needs and medical practices as long as it does not create an adverse impact on the unit's mission.
4. I challenge every Commander and Director to make every effort to ensure the religious needs of our Soldiers, Families and Department of the Army civilians are met.
