ARMY MOTOR VEHICLE FATALITY



A 1ST ARMORED DIVISION, FORT BLISS, TEXAS, SOLDIER WAS KILLED IN AN ARMY MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT ON 5 APRIL 2013. PRELIMINARY REPORTS INDICATE THE DRIVER OF THE VEHICLE LOST CONTROL ON A ROAD NEAR RANGE 50, DONA ANA RANGE COMPLEX, AND THE SOLDIER WAS EJECTED FROM THE VEHICLE DURING THE ROLLOVER SEQUENCE. THE SOLDIER SUSTAINED SERIOUS HEAD INJURIES AND WAS PRONOUNCED DECEASED AT 1424 HRS, 5 APRIL 2013. AN ARMY ACCIDENT INVESTIGATION TEAM IS CURRENTLY CONDUCTING THE INVESTIGATION.
