A 2ND HBCT, 1ST Armored Division, Fort Bliss, Texas, Soldier was killed in a POV crash that occurred on 9 December 2011, at approximately 0240 local El Paso, Texas. The 20 year-old SPC was driving a 2002 Ford Mustang at a high rate of speed North on Zaragoza and was trying to merge onto Montana when the driver lost control and hit the wall of the Montana overpass. The Mustang rolled several times before it landed on its roof. The Soldier died at the scene. Speed and Alcohol are suspected contributing factors. This is Team Bliss's 4TH Privately Owned Vehicle fatality in FY12.
