TAX PREPARATION FAQS

When will the IRS begin accepting tax returns?

The IRS will not begin accepting tax returns, electronically or through the mail, until January 25, 2016.

Where is the Fort Bliss Tax Center located?

There is only ONE Tax Center for the 2016 tax season. This is different from previous years when there were two tax center locations. The Fort Bliss Tax Center will be located in Building AR 404 (across from 1 AD Headquarters).

What do I need to bring?

You need to bring the following: military ID, power of attorneys, social security cards or copies of social security cards for the taxpayer and all dependents, and all tax forms (W-2s, 1099s, 1098, etc), and bank account information for direct deposit refunds.

Will I be able to drop off my returns?

Yes, drop off services are available on an as needed basis.

What hours will the Fort Bliss Tax Center be open?

The Fort Bliss Tax Center will be open Monday-Friday from 0900 to 1700. On Mondays and Wednesdays there will be extended hours until 1830. The location will be open during lunch. The Fort Bliss Tax Center will be open for appointments and walk-ins from 0900 to close (1700 on Tuesday, Thursday, Friday or 1830 on Mondays and Wednesdays).

Who is eligible for tax preparation services at the Fort Bliss Tax Center?

Active duty service members and their dependents, Reservists on active duty for more than 29 days and their dependents, and retirees and their dependents.

Will it cost me anything to get my tax returns done at one of the Fort Bliss Tax Center?

NO! The Fort Bliss Tax Center is 100% FREE. Our IRS certified preparers are able to complete both Federal and State tax returns.

May I volunteer at the Fort Bliss Tax Center?

YES! Volunteer positions are available. Please contact the Fort Bliss Tax Center for more information.
